A full programme of activities on the day of the Grand Final is also planned, together with some world class football.

Commenting on the Generali Foundation's support of the project, Roberto De Blasio, the Chairman of the GENERALI CEE Cup Organising Committee said:

"In just three years, the tournament has gone from being a grassroots project to an established part of the European youth team footballing calendar, and now, with the support of such a high profile company as Generali, we feel that the possibilities are endless.
